The meeting began with short presentations and updates about current projects from attendees. These included collections and preservation-related projects and questions about how to determine candidates for books to move to storage with limited circulation data.

There was general discussion about working toward a possible update of *Facilities Standards for Art Libraries and Visual Resources Collections* (Irvine, ed.; 1991). Attendees agreed that an updated Facilities Questionnaire should be composed and set to the ARLIS/NA membership and other affiliated groups as a first step in the process. Kristina Keogh will prepare a draft document and share it with SIG members. Kasia Leousis also volunteered to share a bibliography she had created in Zotero with resources on library building and renovation.
